



OUR FITNESS TO DRIVE POLICY

As your GP practice, it is not our policy to provide NHS appointments to discuss driving licence applications or fitness to drive. It is the responsibility of the DVLA to assess a patient's fitness to drive.

If you are unsure whether you can drive following a recent illness, hospital stay, on-going medical condition or operation you should contact the DVLA. You must tell the DVLA about some medical conditions as they can affect your driving.

Failure to do this could lead to a fine of up to £1000.
